JUDGMENT

1 Commissioner presiding. Cross-complainant Hanover Commercial
2 Services, Inc. doing business as Best Temporary Services appeared
3 by David G. Moore, Esq. of the firm Reid & Hellyer. The court,
4 having heard evidence in the form of sworn testimony, having
5 taken judicial notice of the case of People v. Sharon Logan,
6 Riverside Superior Court Case No. RIF 090464, having reviewed
7 documents and having noted the default of cross-defendant Sharon
8 Jean Logan aka Sharon Jean Hecox was first entered on December
9 16, 1999, makes the following findings and judgment.

10 1. That at the fifth cause of action for constructive
11 fraud and the sixth cause of action for breach of fiduciary duty
12 is supported by the evidence as against cross-defendant Sharon
13 Jean Logan aka Sharon Jean Hecox;

14 2. That cross-defendant Sharon Jean Logan also known as
15 Sharon Jean Hecox committed constructive fraud and breach of
16 fiduciary duties by reason of theft and embezzlement from her
17 employer, Hanover Commercial Services, Inc. a corporation, doing
18 business as Best Temporary Services of the sum of \$249,032.15;

19 3. That cross-defendant Sharon Logan also known as Sharon
20 Jean Hecox was convicted of a felony in connection with the theft
21 and embezzlement of these monies in the case of People v. Sharon
22 Logan, Riverside Superior Court Case No. RIF 090464, was
23 committed to state prison and has been ordered by that court to
24 pay restitution in the sum of \$150,000.

25 Given the above findings,

26 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, JUDGED AND DECREED that cross-
27 complainant Hanover Commercial Services, Inc. a California
28 corporation doing business as Best Temporary Services recover

1 judgement of \$249,032.15 from cross-defendant Sharon J. Logan
2 also known as Sharon Jean Hecox together with costs of suit in
3 the sum of \$660 for a total judgment in the amount of
4 \$249,692.15.
