

13 1. MEET AND CONFER STATEMENT

14 This dissolution has been clouded by the deliberate misstatements  
 15 of SHARON LOGAN HECOX, as further described below. Her  
 16 misrepresentations to the court include filing repeated false  
 17 criminal charges against JAMES HECOX, filing or threatening to  
 18 file malicious lawsuits against those who she perceives as  
 19 assisting or harboring Mr. HECOX, as well as a number of false  
 20 statements in her CASE STATEMENT.

21

22 Because of the pervasive and deliberate falsehoods employed by  
 23 SHARON LOGAN HECOX, the court is requested to examine any  
 24 evidence offered by her with great care.

25

26 SHARON HECOX is currently the defendant in People v Hecox case #  
 27 RIM 362080 alleging a violation of P.C. 148.5, falsely reporting  
 28 a crime to police. Attached as Exhibit A is a docket sheet from

1 that case.

2

3 Ms. HECOX filed case number SCV 42633 in San Bernardino County  
4 alleging she was sexually harassed in the workplace by Ray Gross.  
5 Mr. Gross and his wife share their home with Mr. HECOX and [REDACTED]  
6 HECOX. Attached as Exhibit F is a letter dated September 17, 1997  
7 from her attorney in that matter. Mr. Gross is expected to testify  
8 that SHARON LOGAN HECOX was never employed at Ray's Delivery  
9 Service.

10

11 The church where Mr. HECOX prays has also been subjected to  
12 threats of legal action by SHARON HECOX. Attached as Exhibit E  
13 are letters dated September 02, 1997; September 04, 1997 and  
14 September 12, 1997 from her attorney to the church and it's  
15 pastor. Exhibit E also includes a document dated July 30, 1997  
16 from Richard Young Ministries and a page of court minutes from  
17 Riverside County case # 301954 dated 10/03/97. The court is  
18 requested to take judicial notice of the entire file in that case,  
19 particularly the declarations submitted by Ms. LOGAN HECOX.

20 SHARON HECOX has made a number of false criminal complaints  
21 against JAMES HECOX. Attached as Exhibit C please find copies of  
22 documents from the Municipal Court of the Pomona Judicial District  
23 of Los Angeles County in Case No. 8PM00332 indicating that charges  
24 were dismissed on February 18, 1998.

25

26 Exhibit C also contains copies of documents from Case No.  
27 MVA016456 filed in San Bernardino County Municipal Court [Valley  
28 Division] showing it was dismissed on December 18, 1997; San

1 Bernardino County Case No. MVA 17559 indicating it was dismissed  
2 on December 18, 1997 and San Bernardino County Case No. 17047  
3 indicating it too was dismissed on December 18, 1997. Each of  
4 these actions was a false criminal charge brought by SHARON HECOX  
5 against JAMES HECOX.

6

7 Against this background of deliberate falsehood, any statement of  
8 Respondent should be seriously questioned.

9

10 2. STATISTICAL INFORMATION

11 Petitioner agrees with the statistical information offered by  
12 Respondent and offers Exhibit D showing the birth certificate and  
13 social security card of CORAL LIN LOGAN [HECOX] the only child of  
14 this marriage.

15

26 There are no issues which have been settled.

9 6. STATEMENT OF FACTS

10 Petitioner and Respondent separated on March 04, 1997. Since that  
11 time, Respondent has embarked on a continuous pattern of  
12 harassment outlined above.

13

14 Respondent insisted throughout their marriage that she handle all  
15 the family finances. This included making payments to  
16 Petitioner's former wife [which Respondent apparently never made].  
17 At all times herein relevant, Respondent told Petitioner she had  
18 made the support payments.

19

20 Petitioner and Respondent purchased a pick-up truck which was  
21 leased to Rays Delivery Service. JAMES HECOX was assigned to  
22 drive the truck delivering trailers to various locations, and  
23 SHARON HECOX, the registered owner of the vehicle, was paid for  
24 the loads delivered.

25

26 JAMES HECOX is not now employed.

27

28 SHARON HECOX lived after their separation with a friend in

1 Riverside. SHARON HECOX stole over a hundred dollars from that  
2 woman by using her ATM card without the knowledge or consent of  
3 the victim.  
4

5 On October 21, 1997 SHARON HECOX mutilated herself and called the  
6 Riverside County Sheriff Department to report that JAMES HECOX had  
7 raped her. She later confessed to Officer King that the injuries  
8 were self inflicted. This incident gave rise to the criminal  
9 charges now pending against SHARON HECOX. Since that time, JAMES  
10 HECOX has had primary custody of their child [REDACTED] LOGAN  
11 (HECOX) SHARON HECOX has been limited to supervised visits with  
12 [REDACTED].  
13

14 On several occasions SHARON HECOX has threatened to remove CORAL  
15 LIN LOGAN HECOX from California to deprive JAMES HECOX of  
16 visitation. These threats have included removal to either New  
17 York or in the alternative SHARON'S native Vietnam.  
18

19 JAMES HECOX and [REDACTED] HECOX live in a stucco home owned by Ray  
20 Gross. Contrary to the allegations of Respondent, the home has  
21 inside plumbing, hot and cold running water, two color television  
22 sets, a CD player and the normal modern amenities. This is a  
23 safe and wholesome environment in which the child can live without  
24 fear or threat of harm from her mother. [REDACTED] HECOX has a  
25 separate bedroom in which she sleeps alone.  
26

27 Given the extreme conduct of SHARON HECOX, her self mutilation,  
28 threats to abduct the parties child, and apparent inability to

1 refrain from fabricated allegations, this court is requested to  
2 limit her to only supervised visitation with [REDACTED] HECOX for the  
3 next two years.

4  
5 The allegation that "...in February of 1998, Mr. Hecox went to the  
6 Respondent's friend's apartment and gave her \$500.00 to remove all  
7 of their community property..." is flatly false.

8  
9 Far from the abuse alleged at page 4 commencing at line 22 of  
10 Respondants papers, it is Petitioner who has suffered an unending  
11 series of attacks in terminating this marriage. The parties  
12 should be permanently restrained from calling each other or being  
13 in each others presence. Respondent should be restrained from  
14 filing lawsuits against the friends of petitioner, specifically  
15 in that she should be held in contempt of this court if she makes  
16 further unfounded allegations against JAMES HECOX, his friends or  
17 associates.

18  
19  
20 7. PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

21 CHILD CUSTODY

22  
23 CURRENT ORDER: Primary physical custody to Petitioner with  
24 Respondent allowed supervised visitation.

25  
26 PROPOSED ORDER: Continuation of the present order for at least two  
27 years.

28

1 In light of the mental instability demonstrated by SHARON HECOX,  
2 her threats to remove [REDACTED] HECOX from Southern California, and  
3 the stable and loving home which [REDACTED] HECOX now enjoys, JAMES  
4 HECOX requests that [REDACTED] HECOX remain in his custody, and that  
5 any visitation be closely monitored.

6

7 CHILD VISITATION

8 CURRENT ORDER: Respondent has supervised visitation.

9 PROPOSAL : VISITATION TO REMAIN SUPERVISED

10 The court is encouraged to take the threats of SHARON HECOX to  
11 abduct [REDACTED] HECOX seriously. Respondent has demonstrated a  
12 willingness to go extreme melodramatic lengths to press false  
13 charges against her husband and those she perceives as supporting  
14 him. Respondent should not be allowed to use this child as a pawn  
15 in her psychological problems, either by being given the  
16 opportunity to abduct the child or being allowed unsupervised  
17 visitation for any amount of time.

18

19 The statements of Joyce Reiswig should be considered those of an  
20 admitted "advocate" for SHARON HECOX. One may well ask if the  
21 opinion of Dr. Reiswig would remain the same were she aware of the  
22 criminal charges pending against SHARON HECOX, the threats of  
23 litigation she has made, and the lawsuit she has filed against Ray  
24 Gross.

25

26 [REDACTED] HECOX lives in a loving, responsible home. She is obviously  
27 in good physical health, and appears to be in fine mental health.  
28 Her father has been away from home one night in the past five and

1 one half months.

2

3 CHILD SUPPORT

4 CURRENT ORDER: There is no current order.

5 PROPOSAL : No support should be awarded.

6 JAMES HECOX is currently unemployed. He receives adequate funds  
7 from the government to provide (with the assistance of Ray Gross)  
8 an appropriate home for [REDACTED].

9

10 SPOUSAL SUPPORT

11 CURRENT ORDER: There is no order for support at this time.

12 PROPOSAL : Respondent is able to support herself, Petitioner  
13 is not now working. Therefore, no support should be awarded.  
14 Petitioner has no idea what basis SHARON HECOX has for the income  
15 allegations set forth in her pleading.

16

17 DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ASSETS

18 CURRENT ORDER: None

19 PROPOSAL : Those assets now in the possession of each party  
20 shall remain with that party.

21

22 Respondent indeed abandon her community property at the residence  
23 of a "friend", the woman from whom she stole over \$100.00 by use  
24 of the victim's ATM card.

25 Petitioner is in possession of the following property:

- 26 1. Petitioner is not in possession of the couch  
27 2. Water bed and dresser

28 Petitioner has the bed, Respondent apparently gave the dresser

1 to a friend. It is not in Petitioner's possession.

2

3 3. Microwave

4 Petitioner has no idea what Respondent did with this item

5

6 4. Dining set

7 Petitioner has this dining set

8

9 5. Oak entertainment center

10 Petitioner is not in possession of this item

11

12 6. Black lamp

13 Petitioner is in possession of this lamp

14

15 7. 1977 pick up truck

16 Petitioner bought this 20 year old vehicle well before marriage,

17 it currently has no engine.

18

19

20 8. Refrigerator

21 Petitioner is not in possession of this item

22

23 9. Family Pictures

24 Petitioner is not in possession of this item

25

26 10. Barbie Collection

27 Petitioner is not in possession of this item

28

1 11. Planet Hollywood Jacket  
2 Petitioner is not in possession of this item  
3

4 COMMUNITY DEBTS

5 During the term of their marriage, Respondent was in full control  
6 of all money earned by Petitioner. She made all business and  
7 significant purchasing decisions. In particular, the 1996 pick  
8 up truck was in her name alone. She had possession of the truck  
9 when the parties separated.

10

11 All of the bills in Respondants name should be assigned to her as  
12 separate property debt. Petitioner has been frustrated in an  
13 attempt to obtain employment by a fear that any potential employer  
14 will face a lawsuit from SHARON HECOX. Having prevented him from  
15 working, SHARON HECOX should not be allowed to ask for a division  
16 of the debts in her name.

17

18 All of the items listed were incurred by Respondent. The credit  
19 cards in her sole name, and the truck in her name alone should be  
20 her sole responsibility.

21

22 DIVISION OF COMMUNITY PROPERTY

23 Petitioner proposes that the community property now in the  
24 possession of each party shall remain with that party. Respondent  
25 has prevented JAMES HECOX from working by both by filing frivolous  
26 lawsuits against his employer and threatening others who has (in  
27 her perception) aided him, and by making a series of false  
28 accusations against him resulting in his repeated arrest. He is

1 currently unemployed.

2

3 In contrast, Respondent admits she left the community property  
4 with "a friend" and alleges JAMES HECOX removed it from that  
5 persons apartment. If Respondent had a genuine interest in the  
6 community property, she should have secured it. Having abandon  
7 her property, she should not be heard to complain.

8

9 EPSTEIN CREDITS

10 All of the debts paid by Respondent were her sole debts.  
11 Petitioner did not owe the money for the items, and should not be  
12 saddled with the obligations.

13

14 ATTORNEY FEES

15 Not only should Respondent be charged with the attorney fees in  
16 this matter, in the event of a defense verdict in HECOX v GROSS,  
17 she should be ordered to pay the attorney fees in that case as  
18 well.

19

20 8. SUMMARY

21 SHARON HECOX has engaged in conduct which is simply outside the  
22 limits of what is acceptable in our society, While her tactics  
23 of attacking the individuals who have aided her husband have been  
24 successful in keeping him without work, and causing him tremendous  
25 emotional strain, the court is asked to end them firmly.

26


27 JAMES HECOX should be kept free of threats that his child will be  
28 kidnaped and removed from southern California, or that his

1 employer will be sued, or his church attacked in retaliation for  
2 ending his marriage.







Please consider this correspondence as our demand for settlement. If you have retained counsel or have in-house counsel, then read no further and transmit this material to your attorneys.

## LIABILITY

My client started working for your organization on March 1, 1994 as a secretary/dispatcher. When she first began her employment, Mr. Gross (who is the owner) would commence making sexual innuendos such as "oh, your husband is on the road. I could service you tonight." Or other statements such as "do you want the real thing tonight or are you going to use the dildo?"

These comments occurred approximately twice per month. The frequency substantially escalated during the last six months of employment from August of 1996 until March 31, 1997.

During this period of time the comments were almost on a daily basis.

He would say things such as "damn it, if I was married to you I would be on top of you every night."

On other occasions he would indicate "what is the matter? Aren't you giving him enough of that pussy?"

Obviously very upset, my client discussed this with her husband and what was said. Ultimately she made it clear that she would not tolerate any further such language.

On other instances he would ask her if her breasts were real and how many times her husband played with them.

This is only a partial and brief description as this situation became very aggravated.

For example, in September of 1996, my client asked him if she could have the complimentary tickets to the Los Angeles County Fair. He indicated that he would gladly provide them to her "just as soon as you come over and give me head."

My client told him "no way in hell." Then he began to laugh and stated, "sure, come on over and get six tickets."

In the close of November my client's husband went on a week-long trip. When he returned, the next morning my client went into the office and this individual stated:

"Well, is your old man still alive? I bet you rode him all night long."

There are other comments such as "do you like them short or long?" or, "I bet you would like my twelve inch cock compared to the usual three inches you normally get."

In the beginning of January, 1997 she was greeted in the morning by him as "Bob" and this occurred for three days. Eventually my client asked him why she was being called that name and he said it was short for "big of boobs." He then would ask if it was okay for him to "rub my face in between your breasts."

After this time and in February, on Valentine's Day, my client and her husband separated.

Apparently learning this information, he called and asked if my client needed him to come over and that "I would be more than happy to give you a mustache ride."

My client then advised him that his name (Gross) fit him well because my client would have to be insane to let him touch her.

Although they never had intercourse together because my client avoided him to the extent possible, when she would walk out the door he was sometimes successful in patting her on her buttocks.

In March, there were comments about one of her breasts and "they must be real because they shake when you walk" and "you must be lonely: do you want to sit on my finger for a while or do you need to borrow a finger or maybe a whole hand?"

Eventually my client found this conduct intolerable and quit.





### Declaration of Sharon Hecox

I Sharon Hecox do state that the following declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I want to state that the Defendant James Hecox who also is my husband has for the last 6 months harassed, stalked, followed, threatened to kill me which is documented on a Sheriffs report has made my life intolerable, James has also sat outside my house in a vehicle across the street staring in through my window. He has stated many times that he wish I would just take him back and that he still really loved me and wanted to work out our marriage. James also says that what I do and where I go and who with is his business as long as I am his wife, he has threatened to mark me up because your so pretty I can not stand anyone else looking at you, you make me hit you because of all the looks you get from other men. He is very jealous and angered easily whenever I go somewhere that he does not know about. James has stated that we can not have peaceful contact that is correct. How peaceful is it when our daughter witnesses her daddy hitting her mommy on more than one occasion. If my accusations against James are false then why on August 1 1997 was he arrested for spousal abuse, spent 29 days in the Robert Presley Center then pleaded guilty. This man has continued to batter, beat and bruise me throughout our separation and he wonders why I will not take him back. He has continually begged for my forgiveness and asked that I drop all charges against him. He has 2 cases in San Bernardino County for spousal abuse and 1 for making terrorist threats. Defendant wonders why I

do not trust him and care not to be around him alone. James has stated many times why cant I just love him and forget about the past .my response to this is when you decide to get the help you need and start taking responsibility for your own actions then maybe we can deal with our marriage. He has made my life intolerable with his outbursts of jealousy and anger, and I fear not only for my safety but that of our daughter [REDACTED]. Not so much of the physical abuse but mentally, he calls here and asks [REDACTED] what is mommy doing, who is over there, did you and mommy go anywhere who with. When she goes over there he plays 20 questions with her and is always asking if she still thinks mommy loves him, and why wont mommy take him back. She comes home confused and asks why daddy is not here and why I do not let daddy come home. I tell her that daddy needs help and when he decided to get counseling for his abusive and violent and extremely angry ways then we will see. I petition the courts to put James through some kind of anger counseling sessions so he can learn to deal with other people especially his wife with kindness and respect.

James states that there is a change in our daughters behavior, well after seeing her mother hit on more than one occasion and her daddy being taken off to jail how is a 5 year old going to act. While James was in jail he called almost every day to ask me and my daughter to come see him, he stated numerous times that he was sorry and could I ever forgive him. James said he loved me more than anything and he was glad that he was in jail because at

least from behind bars he could not hurt me. [REDACTED] on her visits to see her dad in jail was sad and did not understand why daddy keeps getting so mad at mommy and hitting her. Coral also has a change of attitude because she was molested at V.C.C. and also in the Youngs home by one of their foster child. She is currently in counseling with a licensed therapist in Redlands. My lawyer will be happy to furnish you a copy of the lawsuit not only by our daughter but also by another youth that was molested at this so called church. I along with 5 other leaders who have left personally feel that this man Jerry Young is a reproach to the ministry and isnt there something wrong when a church has 3 current lawsuits against it. I happily admit to going to Valley Christian Center on Sep-tember7 1997 I went there on my own and tape recorded a conversation between me and the so called pastor Jerry Young. On the tape he states that James is lying through his teeth. and how could I go there knowing I was not allowed on the premises when I left this cult on my own free will. I have the tape and if the court wishes to hear it I will be more than glad to play it. As for James being a member that is funny, Jerry has stated many times that James is not a member here he only goes because Sharon goes. I submit these letters to the courts that state how many times James has been there. He came at the end of my stay there to purposely harass, annoy, stalk, follow and know my whereabouts at all times. He is obsessed with me and will do everything in his power to make sure I do not have a life away from him. While I still attended this cult he would always stare at me and approach me after to tell me how much he still

loved me and cared for me. My response would be if you still care and loved me you would not use me as a punching bag. I can only hope that he somehow gets the help that is needed for him to try to control his jealous and obsessive ways and if the courts can intervene and get him some help.

James states that his concern is for his daughter and her best interest, well then how come he has made no attempt to see her since he has been out of jail. He has made no attempt to support her in 4 months, he has a son in Kansas who is now 13 years old and he has not seen him since he was 4. He also owes over 18,000 dollars in child support to this son. I ask that the court order child support and spousal support I have proof that he is making over 2000 dollars a month I will submit it at the courts request. In response to the change in his daughter also how would he know what her behavior is like he was in jail for 28 days and before that his last contact was in July on the 25th 1997. When he would request that we come visit him in jail of course she was moody her daddy was behind bars and she knows what daddy did to mommy was wrong. James states that he still loves me and wants to reconcile but on his terms and that I must drop all 3 cases against him. I believe in his own ways that he does love me and cares for me but stalking, harassing, following, and calling all the time is not the way to go about showing me this. I want my daughter to have a relationship with her dad I do not want her to end up like his son, bitter, sad, hurt, and confused with no father figure in his life. My husband has stated that he would

never hurt his daughter but I think a lot of his actions already have harmed her mentally. I would like him to start taking some responsibility in raising [REDACTED] and supporting her. [REDACTED] loves her dad very much and I believe it would be to both their benefit to establish as much time together on weekends as possible.



THE PLAINTIFF IS REQUESTING THAT I TAKE OUR CHILD, [REDACTED] HECOX, EVERY WEEK FROM FRIDAY TO SUNDAY. I WILL AGREE WITH THIS. BUT DUE TO THE PLAINTIFF'S CONTINUAL HARASSMENT AND FALSE ACCUSATIONS TOWARD MYSELF I REQUEST THAT A THIRD PARTY BE INVOLVED IN THE DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP OF OUR CHILD. OUR ORIGINAL COURT ORDER WAS TO MAINTAIN PEACEFUL CONTACT WITH EACH OTHER IN FRONT OF OUR CHILD. THIS HAS FAILED TO WORK. 
